Global objective: Contribute to the stabilization and the early recovery of at-risk communities in Bangui through the revitalization of local economies and the reinforcing of social cohesion.

Specific objective 1: Revitalize local economies and support early recover of conflict-affected communities through cash for work activities to encourage the return of displaced population and support pacific co-habitation.

Specific objective 2: Support and reinforce social cohesion in mixed communities in Bangui through the rehabilitation of community infrastructures.

Specific objective 3: Reinforce the positive perception of the advantages of “living together” through strategic communication, cultural and recreational events.
